Extrait des Sexton Records, sur les décès et inhumations de Natchez

Les *Sexton Records* nous fournissent la confirmation de la mort de mon arrière-arrière-grand-mère. Les centaines de pages qui les composent constituent de plus un document sociologique révélateur des causes de décès à l'époque : la fièvre jaune, la dysenterie, les maladies pulmonaires. La mortalité infantile était très élevée.
